Shuttle: A shuttle will be available for those unable to walk between the churches and to the Capitol. Please indicate on the registration form if you will need this service.

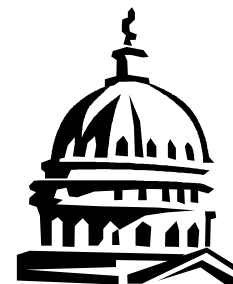
